
Submitted with the application was a statement from the customer, Rod Mattern, that he desires electric service to be provided by the applicant at a point located in:


**NW ¼ of the SE ¼ of Section 27, Township 139N, Range 72W,  
Kidder County, North Dakota**


Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. states that electric service is needed at this location immediately, and the applicant has made a prima facie showing that it should serve the customer.
