RESOLUTION FOR CONDITIONAL USE PERMIT
FOR
CAPX 2020 TRANSMISSION LINE

Whereas, the Normanna Township Zoning Commission has reviewed the letter of intent and route for a proposed high voltage (345kV) electrical transmission through Normanna Township beginning at the centerline on the north side of Section 3 and goes south one mile, then turns east and crosses through the very northern most part of the NE1/4 of Section 10 and NW1/4 of Section 11 and then turns southeast diagonally through the NE1/4 of the NW1/4 and NW1/4 of the NE1/4 of Section 11, then east along the quarter-quarter line of the NE1/4 of Section 11 and the quarter-quarter line of the NW1/4 and NE1/4 of Section 12 of Township 137 North Range 50 West and as described on the attached map,

Therefore, Be it Resolved, that the Normanna Township Board of Supervisors hereby adopts the conditional use permit for the above described route through Normanna Township for a high voltage (345kV) transmission line which will consist of approximately between nineteen and twenty-two steel structures depending on final design with no buildings being required.
