NOTICE OF PUBLIC INPUT SESSION AND INTERVENTION DEADLINE

January 16, 2007

On December 7, 2007 Northern States Power Company (NSP) filed a Notice for Change in Rates for Electric Service under North Dakota Century Code Section 49-05-05 and North Dakota Administrative Code Section 69-09-01-26. NSP proposes a \$20 million or 14 percent increase in its annual North Dakota electric revenues. The proposed rates would affect NSP's service to all of its approximately 85,000 retail electric customers in the State of North Dakota.

A Public Input Session will be held via interactive television on **March 14, 2008, at 11:30 a.m.** central time at locations set forth below. Members of the public are invited to appear and participate in the informal discussion. The session is not considered part of the technical hearing and the discussion at the session will not become part of the evidence reviewed by the Commission in making its decision. The discussion will, however, aid the Commission and its staff in identifying areas of concern to the members of the public and help customers better understand NSP's request.




