As you are aware, the Commission has scheduled a hearing in the matter of Penn Station for Friday, June 20, 2008, at 11:00 a.m. at the Ramsey County courthouse in Devils Lake, North Dakota. This hearing was scheduled at the request of John and Lorrie Sandberg who reside in Penn, North Dakota. It is our understanding that today the Sandbergs filed a letter with the Commission withdrawing their request for a hearing, and further requesting that the Commission not hold a hearing in this case with respect to Penn Station.

We are writing on behalf of our client, Enbridge Pipelines (North Dakota) LLC. Enbridge also urges the Commission to cancel the hearing scheduled for June 20. We have obtained the necessary waiver of construction within 500 feet from the Sandbergs with respect to their residence in Penn.


