NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On January 21, 2008, Otter Tail Corporation, an electric public utility filed an application under Chapter 49-03, N.D.C.C. to extend service to Scott Soulis, near Casselton, in Stutsman County, North Dakota.

Submitted with the application was a statement from the customer, Scott Soulis, that he desires electric service to be provided by the applicant at a point located in:

**NW ¼ Section 28, Township 140N, Range 64W, Stutsman
County, North Dakota**

Otter Tail Corporation states that electric service is needed at this location immediately, and the applicant has made a prima facie showing that it should serve the customer.

Any interested party has the right to file written objection, based on the issue of public convenience and necessity, with the Commission by **June 24, 2008**, and the matter will then be set for hearing. If no objections are received by that date, the application may be granted as requested.
