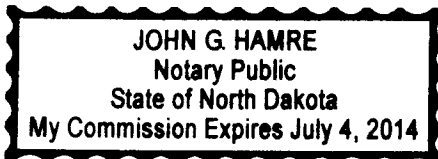

July 30, 2008




On May 16, 2008, M-Power, LLC filed an application for a waiver or reduction of certain procedures and time schedules and a certificate of site compatibility to authorize construction of a 157.5 MW Laverne Wind Farm in Griggs and Steele Counties of North Dakota. On June 19, 2008 the Commission found the application complete and noticed a public hearing that convened on July 29, 2008 in Cooperstown, North Dakota. The hearing was continued to a time and place to be determined.

Please take notice that a continued public hearing on this matter is scheduled to begin **August 25, 2008 at 10:00 a.m. CDT** in the Cooperstown Country Club, 305 Fairway Drive, Cooperstown, ND 58425. The issues to be considered are:

1. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?
4. Is it appropriate for the Commission to waive or procedures and time schedules as requested?
