NOTICE OF HEARING

April 22, 2009

On May 16, 2008, M-Power, LLC (M-Power) filed an application for a certificate of site compatibility to authorize construction of a 157.5 MW Luverne Wind Farm in Griggs and Steele Counties of North Dakota.

On November 6, 2008, the Commission issued a certificate for the northern portion of the project, but required that M-Power submit a final site plan for Commission approval prior to issuance of a certificate of site compatibility for the southern portion of the project. On April 8, 2009, M-Power filed a revised south field turbine site plan as shown on the attached map.

A Public Hearing on the revised south field site plan is scheduled to begin June 5, 2009 at 10:30 a.m. CDT in the Cooperstown City Hall Meeting Room, 611 9th

St NE, Cooperstown, ND 58425. The issues to be considered are:

1. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?

2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?

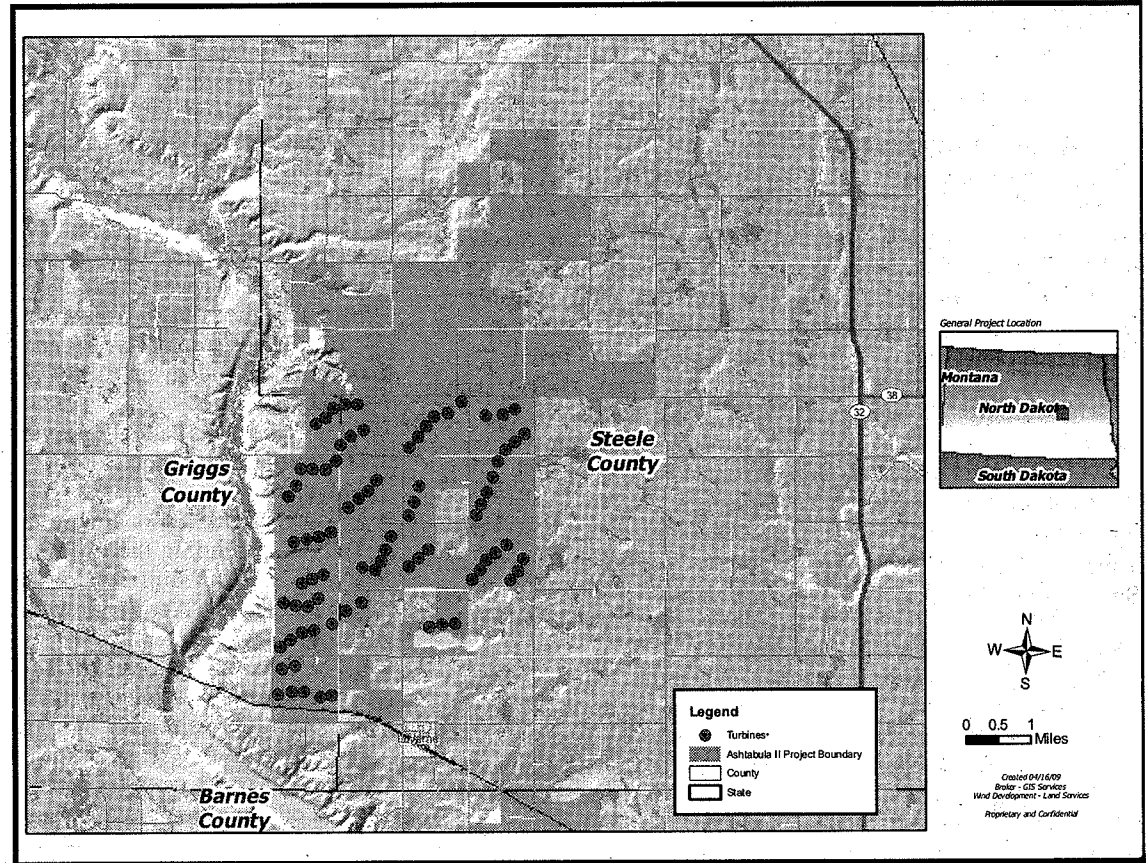
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?
