

**Petition to the ND Public Service Commission for Reevaluation of Setbacks of Industrial Wind Turbines from Dwellings in South Field of Ashtabula II Wind Farm (Summary)**

As landowners, homeowners and business owners located in the south field of the Ashtabula II Wind Farm, we are petitioning for a re-hearing on high-risk placements of turbines #166, 170, 171 and 172 in Broadview Township, Griggs County, ND.

We are concerned about the following five hazards:

- 1.) Turbine brake failure: turbines spin out of control and throw blades and shrapnel
- 2.) Turbine flicker, or strobe-light effect, triggering dizziness, headaches and seizures
- 3.) Vibroacoustic disease from long-term exposure to low frequency pulses and vibration
- 4.) Turbines "throw" ice – the size of car doors – one-half mile at 200 mph
- 5.) Wind Turbine Syndrome (headaches, earaches, sleep deprivation and its man many side effects, elevated blood pressure, depression and more
