Board President Mark Roen called the meeting to order at 6:36 p.m. Other members present: Maria Gasmann and Dave Lakefield. Also present Administrator, Delwyn Groninger, Business Manager, Shannon Erie, and Teacher Representative, Rebecca Severson; and Staff Representative, Barb Bertrand.

Moved by Lakefield, seconded by Gasmann to approve the minutes of the February 17, 2009 regular meeting. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Gasmann, seconded by Lakefield to approve the agenda as amended. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Gasmann, seconded by Lakefield to approve the board bill as presented. Carried unanimously.

Scott Hillestad arrived at 6:42 p.m. Principal's Report

The Principal's Report included discussion on the construction project, Deferred Maintenance Grant, school calendar confusion, Cenex fuel issue, Fresh Fruits and Vegetable Grant, long term sub, end of year play day.

Business Manager's Report: The Business Manager's Report included discussion on small claims court, Ward County Auditor's Office deposit error, bond payment, insurance companies, lunch account balances, food service grants, food service audit, stimulus money, and the upcoming school board election.

Moved by Gasmann, seconded by Lakefield to transfer \$530,000 from general fund to the bonds savings at United Community. Carried unanimously.

Moved by Lakefield, seconded by Gasmann set the date for the Gasmann and Afton township school board member election to June 9, 2009.

South Prairie School is eligible for a maintenance grant. It is a \$15,081 matching grant. Work in the areas of the kitchen, elementary bathrooms, carpet 2, 6, and 8 grade classrooms, classroom window, gym divider, wire-celling projectors, floor drain, and painting.

e. Valuation Northwest e. Valuation Northwest is a company that verifies adequate property insurance is in place. Discussion determined that ND Fire and Tornado had recently done the same procedure. No services would be needed.

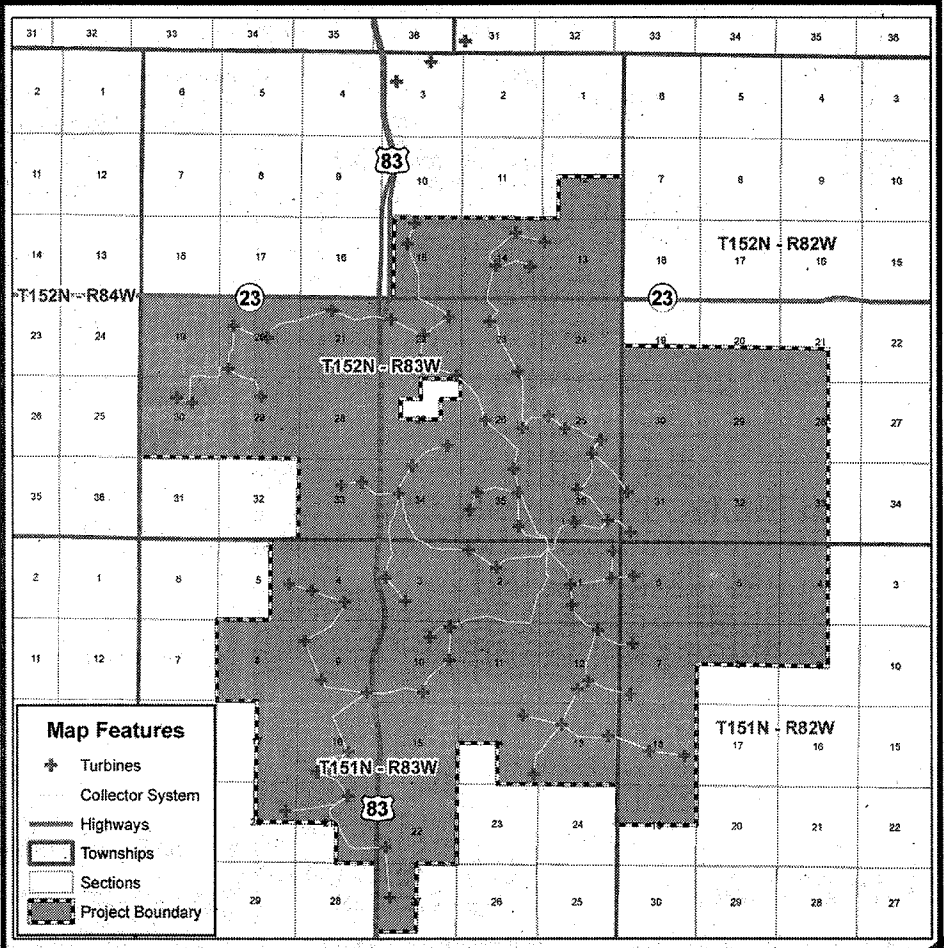

On March 13, 2009, Basin Electric Power Cooperative, Inc. (Basin Electric) filed an application for a certificate of site compatibility to authorize construction of a 115.5 MW PrairieWinds project consisting of up to 77 wind turbine generators and associated facilities in Ward County, North Dakota as shown on the attached map. The Commission finds the application is com-

plete conditioned on Basin Electric filing a map detailing finalized proposed locations for turbines and related facilities on or before May 19, 2009.

A Public Hearing on the application is scheduled to begin May 26, 2009 at 11:00 a.m. CDT in the Minot Municipal Auditorium, 420 3rd Ave. SW, Room 201, Minot, ND 58701. The issues to be considered are:

- 1. Will the location, construction and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?
