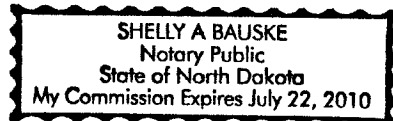

On February 20, 2008 Polar Communications Mutual Aid Corporation (Polar) of Park River, ND filed an application for certificates of public convenience and necessity to provide facilities-based incumbent local exchange telecommunication services in the Gilby, Lakota, Fordville, Edmore, Adams, Pembina, and St. Vincent exchanges in North Dakota. Polar reports merging with subsidiary Polar Telecommunications, Inc. to operate as a single company effective January 1, 2005.


The issues to be considered in these matters are:


1. Fitness and ability of the applicant to provide service.
2. Adequacy of the proposed service.
3. Technical, financial and managerial ability of the applicant to provide service.

Comments and requests for hearings must be received by **May 21, 2008**. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
