

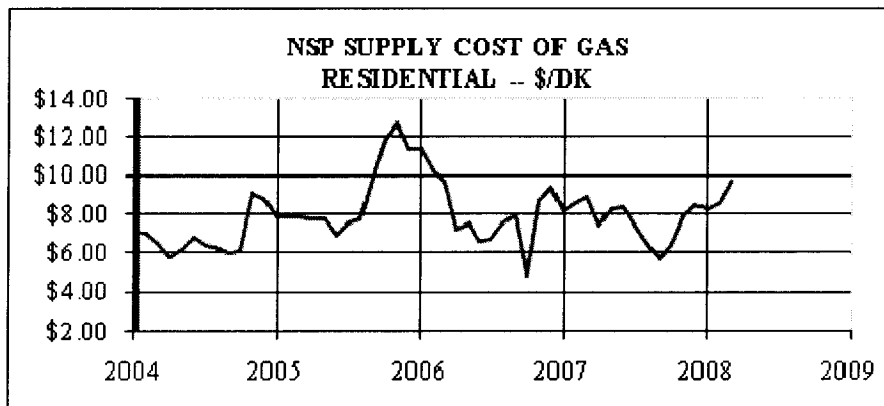

NSP is increasing the cost of gas by \$1.1154 per dekatherm (dK) compared to last month. This cost of gas will be applied to natural gas used by NSP residential customers on and after March 1, 2008. This filing changes the residential customer cost of gas from \$8.6222 per dK to \$9.7376 per dK.

For residential consumption of 11.1 dk (representative of March), the cost of gas in the bill will be approximately \$12.38 higher than last month and \$9.01 higher than March 2007. As of December 31, 2006, NSP served 37,301 residential gas customers, and a total of 43,786 gas customers, in Fargo, Grand Forks and surrounding communities.



The change for residential customers results from:

- \$1.1154 per dk increase in the commodity cost of gas.
- No change in pipeline costs.
