This tariff sets forth the service offerings, rates, terms and conditions applicable to the furnishing of intrastate communications services by MCImetro Access Transmission Services, LLC d/b/a Verizon Access Transmission Services, to residential and small business Customers within the local exchange service area defined herein. Services provided to enterprise and large business customers (i.e., non-mass market customers) are no longer tarified and the rates, terms and conditions of these services can be found in the Service Publication and Price Guide which is available online at [www.verizonbusiness.com](http://www.verizonbusiness.com).

Interim Local Number Portability (ILNP): An optional feature of facilities based services which allow the customer to keep its existing telephone number. ILNP is accomplished via Remote Call Forwarding (RCF). Charges will apply per telephone number.

Joint User: A person, firm or corporation designated by the Customer as a user of local exchange service furnished to the Customer by the Company, and to whom a portion of the charges for such facilities are billed under a joint use arrangement.

LATA: A local access and transport area established pursuant to the Modification of Final Judgment entered by the United States District Court for the District of Columbia in Civil Action No. 82-0192 for the provision and administration of communications services.

Least Idle Trunk Selection (LIDL): LIDL trunk selection occurs when a switching unit selects from a Trunk group the Trunk that has been idle for the shortest period of time.

Local Calling: A completed call or telephonic communication between a calling Station and any other Station within the local service area of the calling Station.

Local Exchange Carrier: A company which furnishes exchange telephone service.

Mbps: Megabits, or millions of Bits, per second.

Message Waiting: This feature provides an indication to a Station User that a message is waiting. Indications may be visual (lamp) or audible (stuttered dialtone).

Most Idle Trunk Selection (MIDL): MIDL Trunk selection occurs when a switching unit selects from a Trunk group the Trunk that has been idle for the longest period of time.

Multiple Appearance Directory Numbers: A directory number that is assigned more than once to one or more Proprietary Business Sets.

Multi-Frequency ("MF"): An inter-machine pulse-type used for signaling between telephone switches, or between telephone switches and PBX/key systems.

Non-Qualified Commercial Affinity Group

An association or affiliation of business entities whose members/individuals are not organized for the sole purpose to qualify for the discounts described herein.

Non-Qualified Residential Affinity Group

An association or affiliation of residential users whose members/individuals are not organized for the sole purpose to qualify for the discounts described herein.
