**PETITION TO
INTERVENE**

On or about March 25, 2008, Langdon Wind, LLC (hereinafter “Langdon Wind”) filed an Application for Partial Transfer of the Certificate of Site Compatibility (“Site Certificate”) issued to Langdon Wind for the 159 MW Langdon Wind Energy Center (“LWEC”) in Case No. PU-07-26 to Otter Tail Corporation d/b/a Otter Tail Power Company (hereinafter “Otter Tail”). Langdon Wind’s application seeks to have transferred to Otter Tail only the rights and obligations of the Site Certificate that coincide with the geographical portion of the LWEC for which the Commission in PU-07-607 issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (“PCN”) to Otter Tail for Otter Tail’s construction and ownership of a 40.5 MW portion of the 159 MW LWEC.

Pursuant to NDAC § 69-02-02-05, Otter Tail petitions to intervene in support of Langdon Wind’s Application. Inasmuch as Langdon Wind seeks to partially transfer to Otter Tail the rights and obligations of the Site Certificate that coincide with the 40.5 MW portion of the LWEC owned by Otter Tail, petitioner has a legal interest that may be substantially affected by the proceeding. Furthermore, intervention would not unduly broaden the issues or delay the proceeding.

Otter Tail is aware of the Commission’s April 23, 2008 approval of the issuance of a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing on Langdon Wind’s Application. Regardless of

the Commission's action on this petition to intervene, Otter Tail does not expect to request a hearing on Langdon Wind's application.


Attached for filing contingent upon favorable action on this petition to intervene is an Affidavit of Chuck MacFarlane, President of Otter Tail Power Company, indicating Otter Tail's assent to the rights and obligations of the Site Certificate which coincide with the 40.5 MW portion of the LWEC owned by Otter Tail.

WHEREFORE, Otter Tail respectfully requests that the Commission

1. Grant this petition to intervene;
2. File for record the Affidavit of Chuck MacFarlane;
3. Grant to Langdon Wind, without hearing, a partial transfer to Otter Tail of the Site Certificate issued in PU-07-26 for the rights and obligations of the Site Certificate that coincide with the geographical portion of the LWEC for which the Commission in PU-07-607 issued a PCN to Otter Tail for Otter Tail's construction and ownership of a 40.5 MW portion of the 159 MW LWEC; and
4. Grant such other relief as the Commission shall deem appropriate.



AFFIDAVIT OF CHUCK MACFARLANE

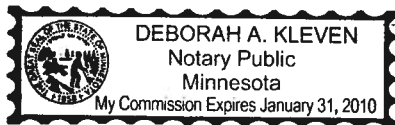
1. I am employed by Otter Tail Power Company as President, and I make this affidavit on the basis of my own personal knowledge and belief as to the matters contained herein.



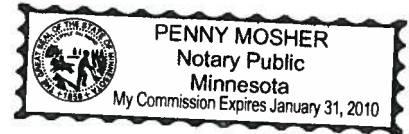
