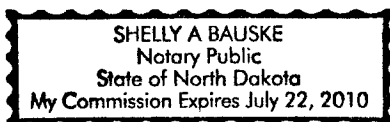

ORDER GRANTING INTERVENTION

May 21, 2008

On May 31, 2007, in Case No. PU-07-26, the Commission issued Certificate of Site Compatibility No. 6 to Langdon Wind, LLC (Langdon Wind) authorizing construction of a 159 MW Langdon Wind Energy Center (LWEC) in Cavalier County, North Dakota. As the Commission found in Finding of Fact #13 of its decision approving issuance of the certificate, Otter Tail Corporation d/b/a Otter Tail Power Company (Otter Tail) then had an option to own a 40.5 MW portion of the LWEC. Otter Tail exercised its ownership option and was issued Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity No. 5336 for its 40.5 MW portion of the LWEC on November 26, 2007 in Case No. PU-07-607.

On March 26, 2008, in the captioned Case No. PU-08-159, Langdon Wind filed an Application for Partial Transfer of Certificate of Site Compatibility, seeking to have transferred to Otter Tail only the rights and obligations of the site certificate that coincide with the geographical portion of the LWEC for which the Commission issued a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to Otter Tail in Case No. PU-07-607.


On May 12, 2008, Otter Tail filed a petition to intervene in support of Langdon Wind's application. Having considered Otter Tail's petition, the Commission finds that Otter Tail has an interest in these proceedings that is not adequately represented by other parties and its participation will not unduly broaden the issues or delay the proceeding. Therefore, the Commission issues the following:


Order

1. Otter Tail's petition to intervene is granted.
2. Admission as an intervenor shall not be construed as recognition by the Commission that an intervenor might be aggrieved by an order of the Commission in this case.
