

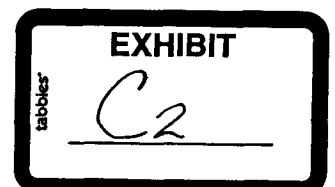
INTERROGATORY NO. 3: List all federal and state matters in which Mr. Hanson has testified or provided documentary evidence concerning rural local exchange service, universal service and/or telephone competition in the last ten years.

ANSWER NO. 3: Mr. Hanson has provided testimony to the ND Public Service Commission in the past ten years. In case No. PU-07-672, Mr. Hanson provided testimony and responded to questions regarding Universal Service Principles and the obligations they impose on rural telephone companies. On information and belief, no transcript of his hearing testimony was made. Mr. Hanson did provide pre-filed testimony in that case.

INTERROGATORY NO. 4: List all federal and state matters in which Mr. Del Fiacco has testified or provided documentary evidence concerning rural local exchange service, universal service and/or telephone competition in the last ten years.

ANSWER NO. 4: Missouri Valley objects to this interrogatory in that is overbroad, and unduly burdensome. Mr. Del Fiacco's responsibilities require the regular filing of reports with federal and state telephone regulators, including the FCC, the Commission, USAC, and NECA, among others.

INTERROGATORY NO. 5: Note I to the financial statements of the Company for the years ended December 31, 2006 and December 31, 2005 describes "a receivable from Nemont Telephone Cooperative, Inc. for a reimbursement due to the utilization of the Company's current tax benefit" of \$2,503,967 as of December 31, 2006. Provide a full description of the provisions for payment of that receivable to the Company.



ANSWER NO. 5: The \$2,503,967 on the books at year end 2006 was paid to MVC during the year 2007 (Nemont collected the amount from the subsidiaries who received the benefit thorough intercompany transactions and remitted to MVC). The amount on the books at year end 2007 was \$529,352 which will be paid during 2008 in the same manner as 2007.
