Dear Sue,

This year we are temporarily leasing grain bins at Barlow Grain & Stock Exchange and Colfax Farmers Elevator. We will not be leasing any grain bins at Engstrom Bean & Seed. We are using these companies as receiving stations. Richland needs to license these bins under our grain license# 1102. The bin descriptions are as follows:

Barlow Grain & Stock Exchange (License# ?):

- Section E, Bin #106 and #107 – Capacity 34,914 bu each.
- Section F, Bin #1 and #2 – Capacity 38,982 bu each.
- Section F, Bin #6 – Capacity 20,000 bu.
- Total Capacity at Barlow = 167,792 bu
- Previously had 148,678 bu at Barlow on our license so increase will be 19,114 bu.

Colfax Farmers Elevator (License# 149):

- Section H, Bin# 1, 2 and 3 – Capacity 9,440 bu each
- Section H, Bin# 6, 7 and 8 – Capacity 14,864 bu each
- Total Capacity at Colfax = 72,912 bu.
- Previously had 24,304 bu at Colfax on our license so increase will be 48,608 bu.
- Please delete bins #4 and #9 in Section H at Colfax.

Engstrom Bean & Seed (License# 1163):

- Last year capacity was at 32,101 bu.
- This year total capacity is 0, so decrease of 32,101 bu.
- Please delete bins #55, 59 and 60 at Engstrom.

The total bushel increase is 35,621. Increasing our capacity from 381,983 bushels to 417,604 bushels. Our current bond is at \$200,000 and we have a request in to Larry Ash Agency Inc. to increase this to \$225,000.
