NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On June 19, 2008, Montan-Dakota Utilities Co. (MDU) filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct and own a 7.5 MW Recovered Energy Generator and associated 41.6 kV electric transmission facilities extending from Northern Border Pipeline Company's compressor station near Glen Ullin in Morton County, North Dakota.

The issues to be considered in this matter are:


1. Whether public convenience and necessity will be served by construction and ownership of the facilities.
2. Whether the applicant is fit, willing and able to provide service.

Those interested are invited to comment on this application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. Comments and requests for hearing must be received by **August 8, 2008**. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
