## NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

August 13, 2008

On August 23, 2006, in Case No. PU-06-312, the Commission issued Corridor Certificate No. 92 and Route Permit No. 102 to FPL Energy Oliver County Wind, LLC (Oliver Wind) for the construction and operation of approximately 542 feet of 230 kV electric transmission line beginning at a new Oliver Substation and extending to an interconnect with Square Butte Cooperative's existing Center Substation, all within the SE 1/4 of Section 33, T142 N, R 83 W, Oliver County, North Dakota.

On May 29, 2008, FPL Energy Oliver County Wind, LLC and FPL Energy Oliver Wind I, LLC (Oliver Wind I) filed a joint application requesting that Corridor Certificate No 92 and Route Permit No. 102 be transferred to Oliver County Wind I, LLC. Ap-

plicants report that Oliver Wind intends to transfer the entire Oliver Project, including the Transmission Line, and all related permits and approvals, including the Corridor Certificate and Route Permit, to Oliver Wind I by means of an asset transfer.

Those interested are invited to comment on this application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. Comments and requests for hearing must be received by September 15, 2008. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.

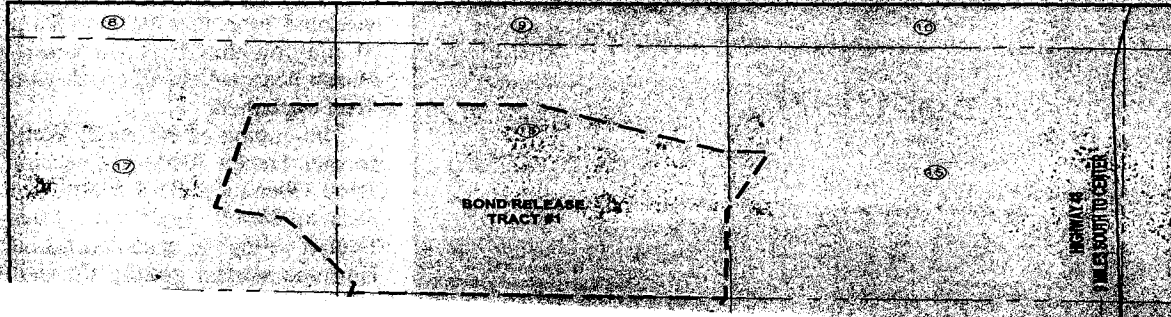
The issues to be considered in this matter are whether Oliver Wind I agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of the siting certificates and permits currently issued to Oliver Wind, and whether the requested certificate/permit transfers are compatible with the public interest.

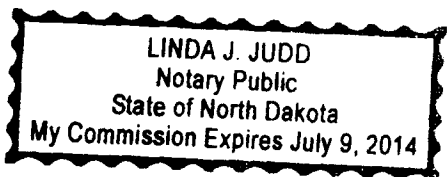
