Letter of Intent / Application for Waiver of Procedures and Time Frames

Ms. Jeffcoat-Sacco:

Pursuant to Section 49-22-07.01 of the North Dakota Century Code and Section 69-06-03-01 of the North Dakota Administrative Code, Plains All American Pipeline LP ("PAA") hereby files its letter of intent to construct a 6-inch crude oil pipeline from its existing Killdeer Crude Oil Gathering system in Dunn County, ND to a connecting point on its existing 6 inch crude oil pipeline 2 miles northwest of Dickinson, in Stark County, ND. PAA requests at this time that the Commission waive or modify the requirement that a Letter of Intent be filed one year before filing an application.

1. Description of Pipeline and area to be served.

The proposed pipeline will connect an existing Plains crude oil gathering pipeline system in the Killdeer Hills area of Dunn County, with an existing Plains crude oil gathering pipeline in the Dickinson area of Stark County.

Ongoing development drilling in Dunn County has prompted shippers and producers to look for crude oil pipeline transportation to Baker, MT and on to the Guernsey, WY markets. Movement of oil production in Dunn County is currently limited to deliveries to Tesoro Pipeline (Mandan Refinery), or some that is trucked up to 100 miles to other pipelines in the western part of the North Dakota. Installation of this pipeline will allow PAA to provide crude oil transportation out of the Dunn County area, to markets in Guernsey WY.

PAA is proposing a 6 inch steel crude oil pipeline connecting its Killdeer Gathering System and its Dickinson Gathering System, a distance of approximately 33 miles with a capacity of about 10,000 bbls per day. Pumps will be located at the current Killdeer Station. No additional tanks will be constructed.

2. Map of Pipeline Route

A vicinity map is enclosed.

3. Estimated Cost of Construction and Schedule.

PAA estimates that the total cost of constructing this pipeline is approximately \$16,000,000. PAA anticipates construction commencing and completing the construction in the first half of 2009.

4. Request for waiver of time frames.

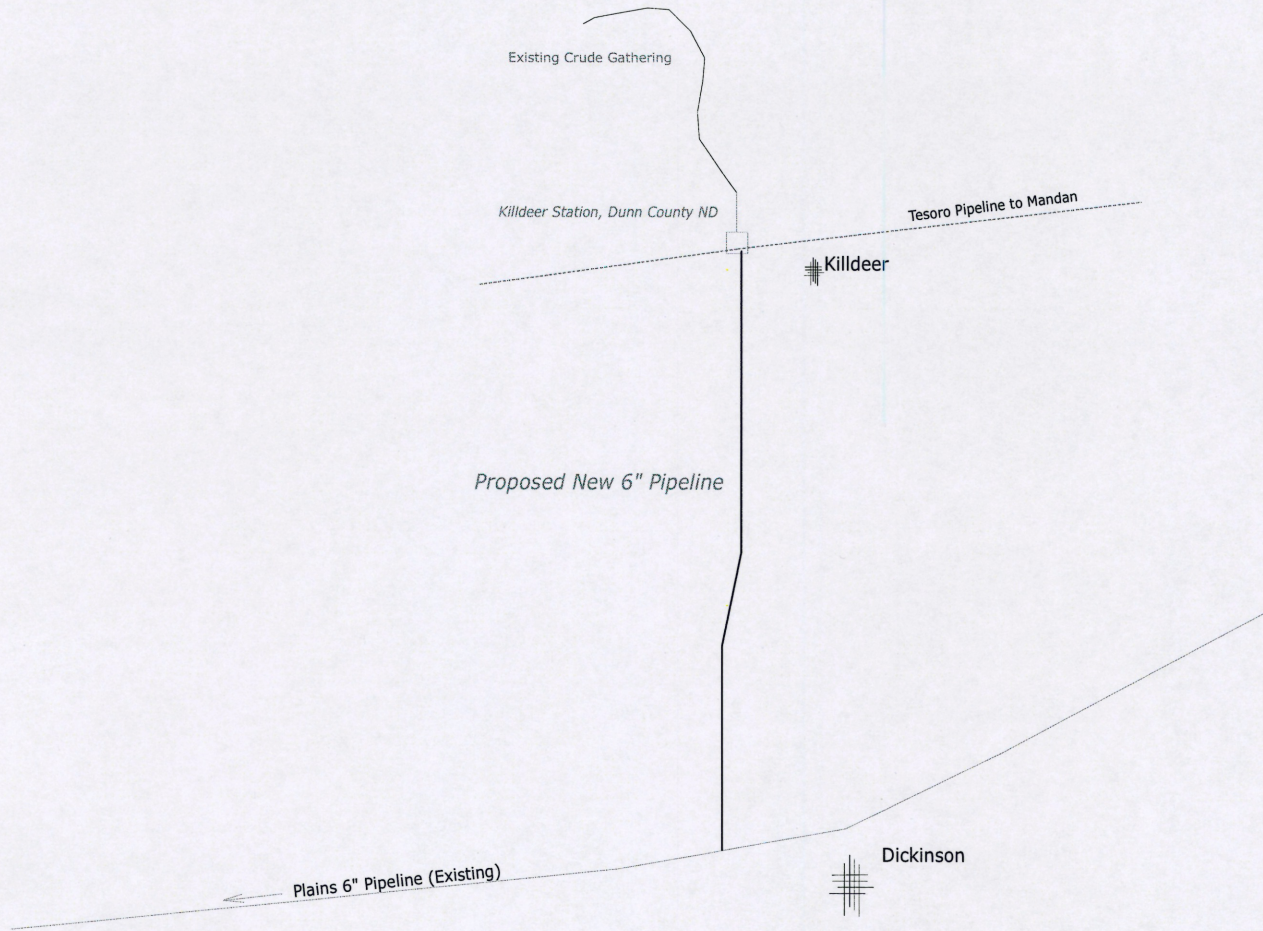
