


Submitted with the application was a statement from the customer, Rich Vestal, that he desires electric service to be provided by the applicant at a point located in:

SW ¼ of Section 20, Township 154N, Range 100W, Williams County, North Dakota.

Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. states that electric service is needed at this location immediately, and the applicant has made a prima facie showing that it should serve the customer.

Any interested party has the right to file written objection, based on the issue of public convenience and necessity, with the Commission by **September 3, 2008**, and the matter will then be set for hearing. If no objections are received by that date, the application may be granted as requested.
