Dear Brad,

We received your request to make changes to your current storage operations in Fargo. Our grain warehouse inspector, Rick Fillbrandt, plans to visit your facility in Fargo on Tuesday, September 9 or Wednesday, September 10. At that time, you can give Mr. Fillbrandt the information he will need regarding the specific bins that will be deleted and those that will remain licensed.

The new storage facility at Jamestown cannot be operated under the Fargo license or Binsmade license. You must obtain a separate license for Jamestown. Enclosed is an application form. Please complete this form and submit it along with the applicable license fee, a sample of the scale ticket that will be used at Jamestown and a revised storage and delivery policy.

Contact your bond company and ask that they issue a bond rider which shows the Jamestown location. Also contact your insurance company and ask that they issue a Certificate of Insurance on Grain for the Jamestown facility. Mr. Fillbrandt will visit with you (or Randy Wigen) next week to gather information he will need to develop bin charts and diagrams for the Jamestown facility. Once Mr. Fillbrandt completes the bin charts and diagrams, he will inform you if the bond must be increased.
