NOTICE EXTENDING OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On November 25, 2008, Saddle Butte Pipeline LLC filed an application for a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity to construct and own a natural gas and crude oil pipeline system in McKenzie and Dunn Counties. On December 31, 2008, the Commission issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing in this proceeding providing until January 30, 2009 for comments and requests for hearing.
