Rebels Top Tornadoes

After a severe blizzard postponed the Dakota Holiday Tournament, the opening rounds were played on Monday, January 3 in Ellendale. The Tornadoes faced the Edgeley-Kulm Rebels.

The Tornadoes would come out very flat to begin the game, falling behind quickly 9-0. After a timeout the Tornadoes picked up their intensity both offensively and defensively, and tried to overcome the early deficit. Foul trouble and missed shots would hamper the Tornadoes, but they would chip away at the lead. After one quarter of play the Rebels kept the lead 18-11.

The second quarter had the Tornadoes continuing their full court defensive pressure. Turnovers and mistakes by the Rebels would allow the Tornadoes to score easy baskets. Foul trouble would continue to hurt the Tornadoes and would allow the Rebels to shoot free throws for most of the quarter. At halftime the Tornadoes cut the lead to six points by a score of 29-23 Rebels.

The third quarter began well for

the Tornadoes, as they would continue to frustrate the Rebels with their changing defenses and traps. Steals and fast break scores would allow the Tornadoes to cut the lead to two points with only a few minutes left in the third quarter. The quarter would take a turn for the worse for the Tornadoes, as several careless turnovers would lead to easy scores for the Rebels. On October 6, 2010, enXco Development Corporation filed an application for a certificate of site compatibility to authorize construction of a 150 MW Merricourt Wind Power Project consisting of up to 100 wind turbine generators and associated facilities in Dickey and McIntosh Counties of North Dakota as shown on the attached map.

A previously scheduled Public Hearing on the application was cancelled due to weather and is now rescheduled to begin on February 10, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. CST at Teddy's Grill, 1101 Industrial Park, Edgeley, ND 58433. The issues to be considered are:

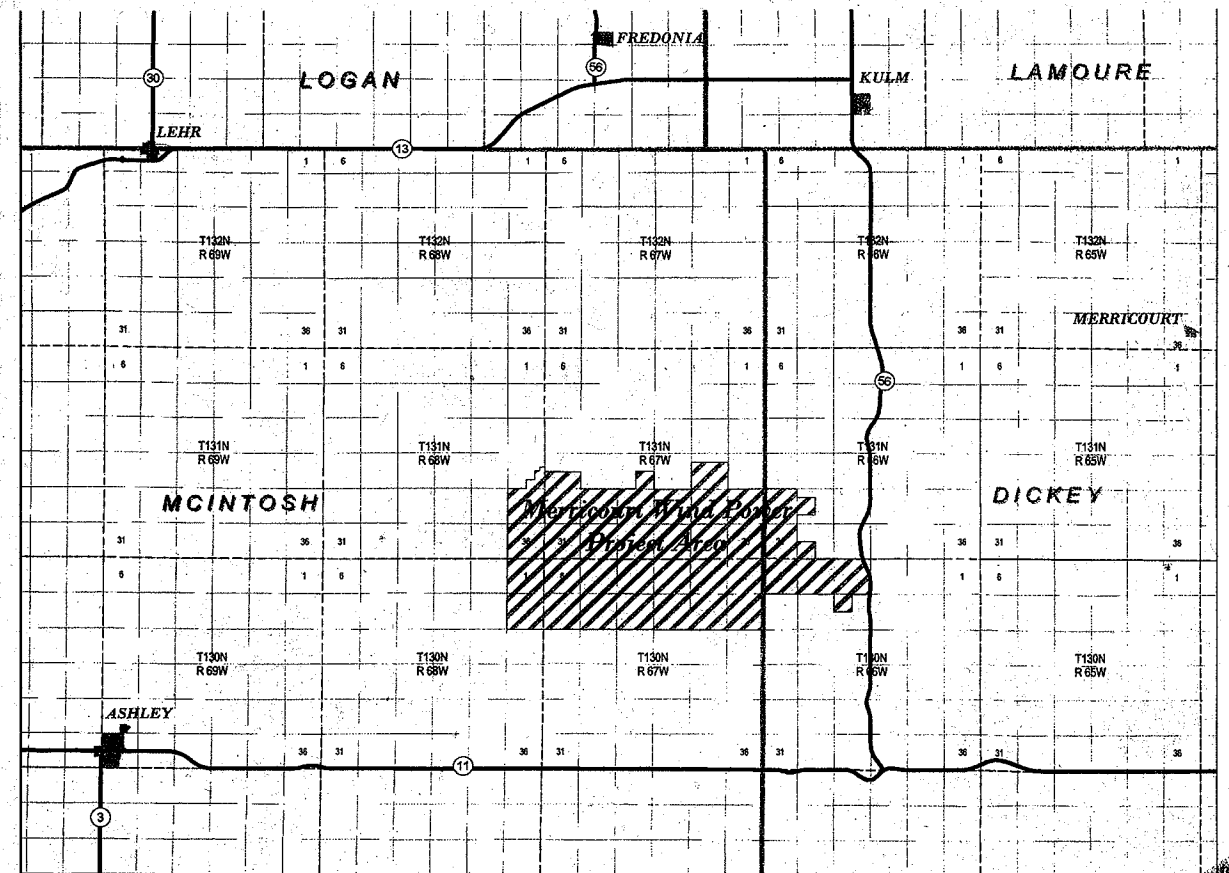
