**NOTICE OF RESCHED-
ULED HEARING**
April 15, 2011

On February 7, 2011, Mon-
tana-Dakota Utilities Co., A division
of MDU Resources Group,
Inc., (MDU) filed an application
for a waiver of procedures and
time schedules, a corridor certificate
and a route permit to au-
thorize construction of
approximately 30 miles of 230 kV
electric transmission line and as-
sociated facilities in Dickey and
McIntosh Counties of North
Dakota, as shown on the at-
tached map.

MDU requests the Commis-
sion waive procedures and time
schedules set forth in North
Dakota Century Code chapter

49-22 and North Dakota Ad-
ministrative Code article 69-06
to allow for a single consoli-
dated application for corridor
certificate and route permit and
to hold a combined hearing on
the waiver request and applica-
tion for corridor certificate and
route permit.

On March 18, 2011 the Com-
mission issued a Corrected No-
tice of Filing and Notice of
Hearing to be held April 15,
2011. That public hearing was
cancelled due to inclement
weather and is now resched-
uled to begin May 12, 2011, at
2:00 p.m. CDT at the Dickey
County Courthouse, 309 2nd
St, Ellendale, ND 58436. The
issues to be considered are:

1. Will the location, construc-
tion, and operation of the pro-
posed facilities produce
minimal adverse effects on the
environment and upon the wel-
fare of the citizens of North
Dakota?

2. Are the proposed facilities
compatible with the environ-
mental preservation and the ef-
ficient use of resources?

3. Will the proposed facility
locations minimize adverse
human and environmental im-
pact while ensuring continuing
system reliability and integrity
and ensuring that energy needs
are met and fulfilled in an or-
derly and timely fashion?

4. Is it appropriate for the
Commission to waive proced-
ures and time schedules as
requested, including the re-
quest for a single consolidated
application for corridor certifi-
cate and route permit?

citizens of North Dakota?

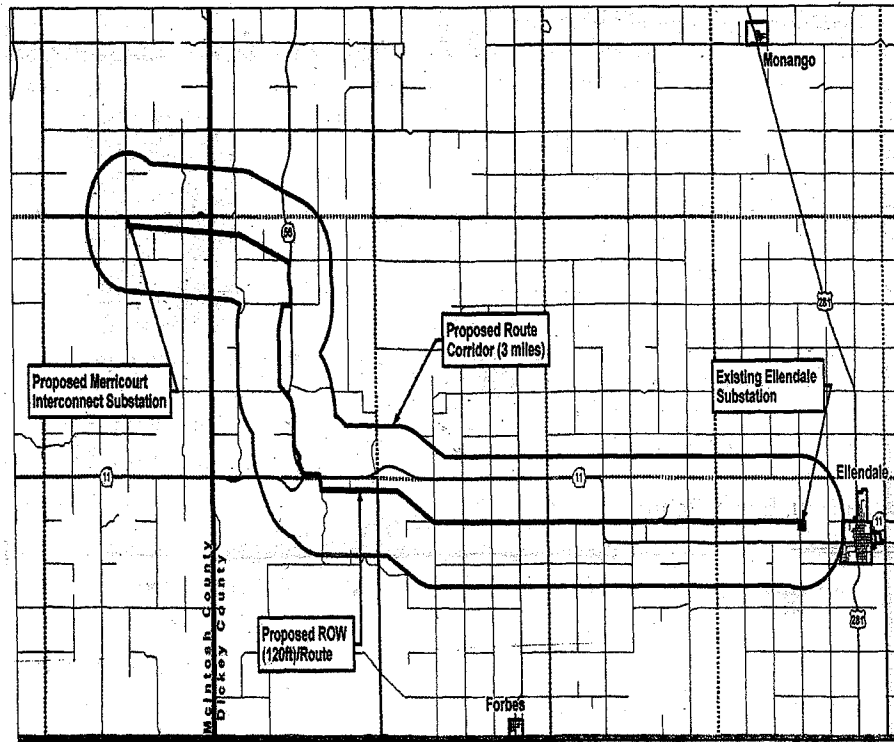
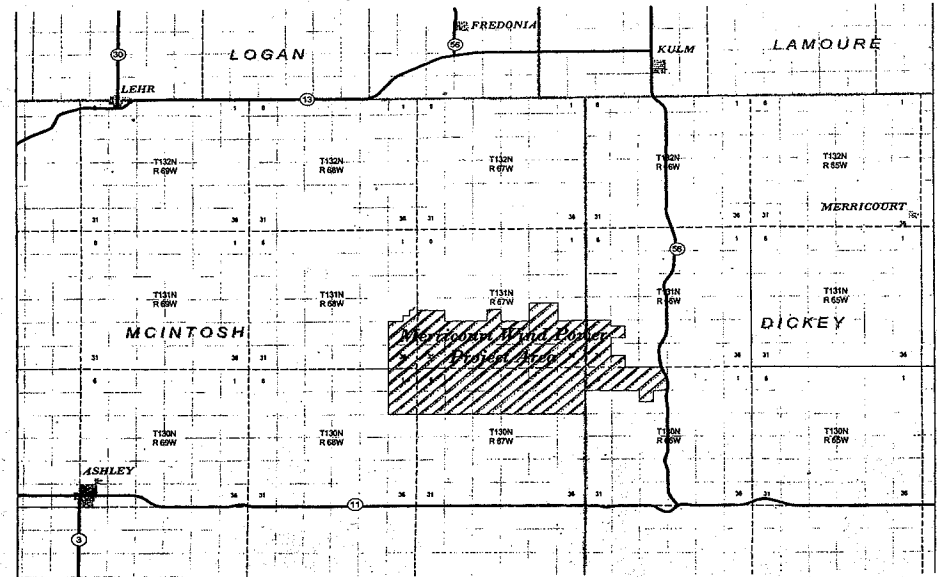
