

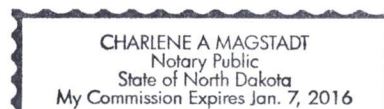

**NOTICE OF CONTINUED HEARING**  
**January 22, 2015**

On June 8, 2011, the Commission issued Certificate of Site Compatibility No. 23 to enXco Development Corporation (enXco) authorizing construction of its proposed 150 MW Merricourt Wind Power Project consisting of up to 100 GE 1.5 MW wind turbine generators and associated facilities in Dickey and McIntosh Counties of North Dakota.

On October 10, 2014, EDF Renewable Development, Inc. (EDF Renewable) fka enXco filed an application for a revised site plan consisting of up to 75 Vestas V100 2.0 MW turbines and associated facilities within the previously-designated project area shown on the attached map.


On November 6, 2014 the Commission deemed the application for a revised site plan complete and issued a Notice of Filing and Notice of Hearing, scheduling a public hearing for December 22, 2014. On December 22, 2014 the Commission issued a Notice of Continued Hearing, rescheduling the hearing for January 22, 2015 because of inclement weather. Again on January 22, 2015 the Commission continued the hearing a second time because of inclement weather.

A continued **Public Hearing** on the application for revised turbine layout is scheduled to begin **on March 19, 2015 at 11:00 a.m. CST at City Hall, 113 1<sup>st</sup> Street NW, Ashley, ND 58413.** The issues to be considered are:

1. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?
