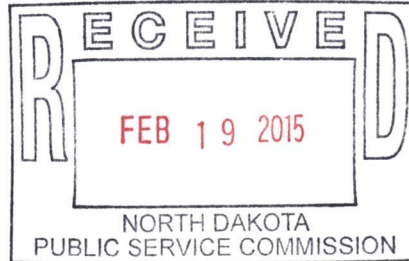

CERTIFICATION OF CONTINUING SITE SUITABILITY

I, Christopher Sternhagen, state and represent as follows:

1. I am employed by EDF Renewable Energy (formerly enXco Development Corporation) and have been the project developer for the Merricourt Wind Project planned for Dickey and McIntosh Counties of North Dakota since 2008.
2. The project site was deemed suitable for development of the planned Merricourt Wind Project and enXco Development Corporation was granted a Certificate of Site Compatibility for Energy Conversion Facility in June of 2011 (Certificate Number 23) (the "Certificate").
3. As of this date, the Merricourt project is yet to be built and the Energy Conversion and Transmission Facility Siting Act of North Dakota (the "Energy Siting Act") requires a certification of continued suitability for projects that have not commenced construction within four years after the Certificate was originally issued.
4. I now make this certification in accordance with North Dakota Century Code Section 49-22-17 and Section 69-06-09-01 of the North Dakota Administrative Code.
5. Based on the information described below, I believe the site continues to meet the conditions upon which the Certificate was issued and am not otherwise aware of anything that would have changed at the site to affect such suitability.
6. The information I have relied upon in determining continued site suitability includes the analysis done in support of the original Certificate, as well as the more recent analysis done in support of our petition to amend the Certificate to include a new turbine model and revised turbine layout. The above referenced analysis is all publicly available in the North Dakota Public Service Commission Docket PU-08-932.
7. I also have relied on the confirmation from our technical consultants, Kadmas, Lee, & Jackson, Inc. ("KLJ") that the site has not undergone any material change affecting its suitability for wind development.
8. Subject to change, EDF Renewable Energy desires to commence construction of the Merricourt Wind Project by June of 2016.

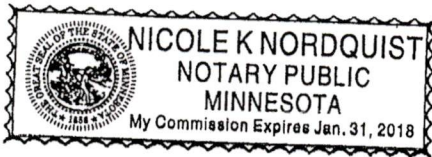
