

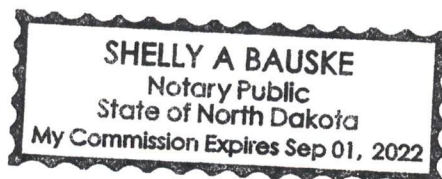

NOTICE OF RESCHEDULED HEARING

July 26, 2017

A **Public Hearing** on the application in Case No. PU-08-932 originally scheduled for June 28, 2017 has been **rescheduled to begin September 13, 2017 at 10:30 a.m. CDT at City Hall, 113 1st Street NW, Ashley, ND 58413.**

On May 27, 2015, the Commission issued First Amended Certificate No. 23 to EDF Renewable Development, Inc. (EDF) fka enXco authorizing a revised site plan for its proposed 150 MW Merricourt Wind Power Project consisting of up to 75 turbines and associated facilities within a previously-designated project area in Dickey and McIntosh Counties of North Dakota.

On March 3, 2017, EDF filed an Application for Second Amendment to Certificate of Site Compatibility, requesting further site plan revisions and turbine location flexibility within revised and expanded project area boundaries as shown on the attached map. The issues to be considered in this proceeding are:

1. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?

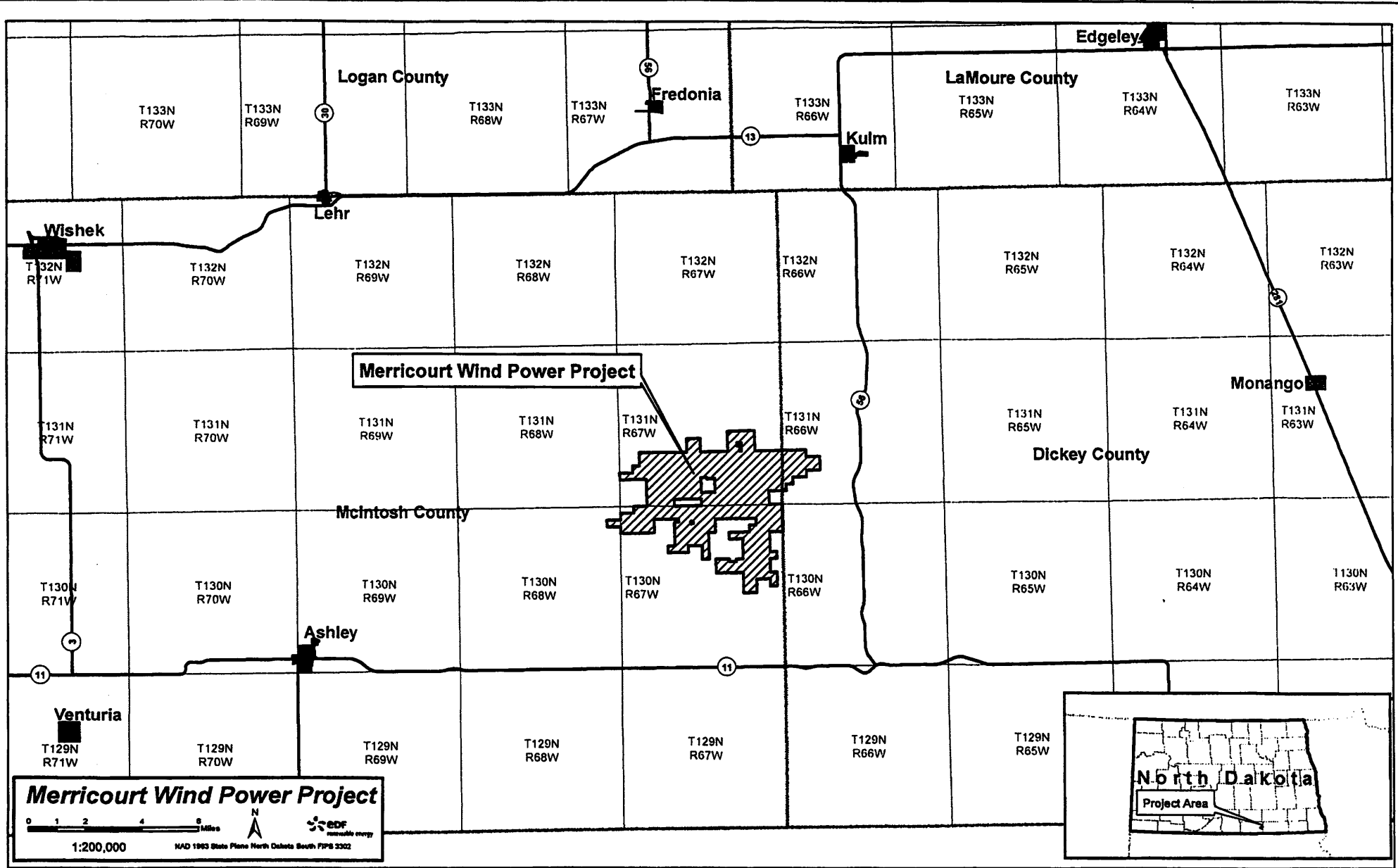
