RECLAMATION OF ABANDONED MINE LANDS

The Abandoned Mine Lands Division of the North Dakota Public Service Commission (AML) has issued Invitation for Bids (IFB) for the 2009 Williams County Road 9 Phase 4, AML reclamation project. The State seeks bids for rotary drilling, casing, coring, grout formulation and pressure grout injection into abandoned underground coal mines, and related construction services for this project near Williston, ND.


