ORDER GRANTING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE & NECESSITY

May 20, 2009

On April 21, 2009, Otter Tail Corporation, an electric public utility, filed an application under Chapter 49-03, N.D.C.C. to extend electrical service to Dwight Fraedrich at a location in Cass County, North Dakota.

On April 29, 2009, the Commission issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing in this proceeding. The Notice provided if no objections were received by June 2, 2009, the application would be granted as requested. No objections have been received.

On May 8, 2009, Cass County Electric Cooperative notified the commission via written correspondence that they will not object to the provision of electric service by Otter Tail Corporation to Dwight Fraedrich at this location.



SE ¼ Section 33, Township 137N, Range 55W, Cass County, North Dakota


