Dear Mr. Fahn:

I am writing on behalf of my client Rough Rider Wind I, LLC (“Rough Rider”), an indirect wholly owned subsidiary of NextEra Energy Resources, LLC, in regard to your February 22, 2022 request for information filed in Case No. PU-09-084 as Docket No. 42. The request seeks information regarding the status of the Rough Rider Wind I Energy Center proposed to be located in Dickey County, North Dakota.

To date, no construction has occurred on the wind project. Rough Rider reserves its right to continue to evaluate options regarding development of the project. In accordance with North Dakota Century Code Section 49-22-17, a utility that has obtained a certificate or permit “may proceed to construct or improve such site or route for the intended purposes at any time” provided it submits the required information and certification to the Commission for construction commencing more than four years after the certificate and permit were issued. Rough Rider will comply with the provisions of Section 49-22-17 for any future construction and provide the necessary information as applicable.
