On September 28, 2009 Hawthorn Oil Transportation (North Dakota), Inc. (Hawthorn) filed an application for a waiver of certain procedures and time schedules and a consolidated application for certificate of corridor compatibility and route permit for the construction of a six-mile, eight-inch diameter, crude oil pipeline in Mountrail County, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map. 3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?
4. Is it appropriate for the Commission to waive procedures and time schedules as requested, including the request for a single consolidated application for corridor certificate and route permit?

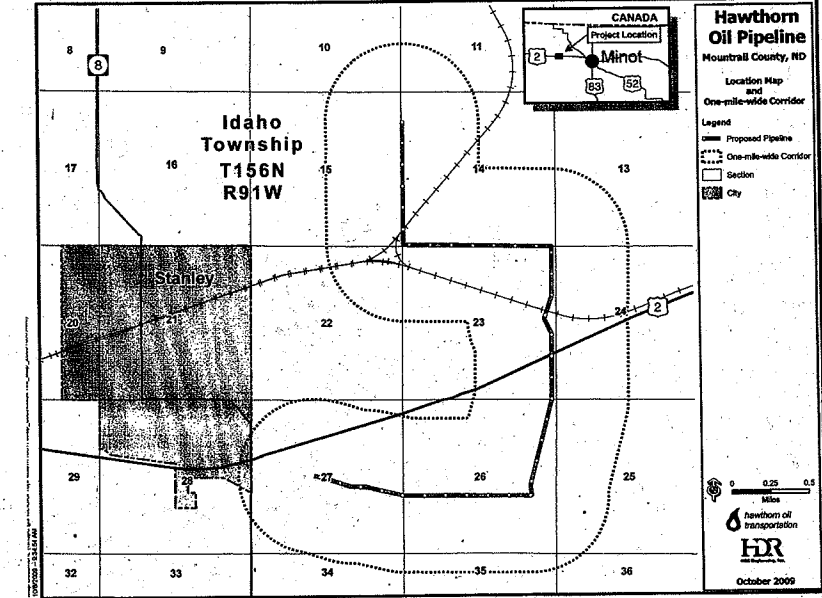
