NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING
June 3, 2009

On October 30, 2008, in Case No. PU-08-34, the Commission issued Certificate of Site Compatibility No. 9 to M-Power, LLC (M-Power) authorizing construction of Phase II of its proposed Luverne Wind Farm consisting of 33 turbines and associated facilities totaling 49.5 MW of nameplate generating capacity in Steele County, North Dakota.

Also on October 30, 2008, in Case No. PU-08-107, the Commission issued Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 106 and Route Permit No. 116 to M-Power authorizing construction of approximately 13 miles of 230 kV transmission line and associated facilities in Barnes and Steele County, North Dakota.

On May 20, 2009, in Case Nos. PU-09-73 and PU-09-136, the Commission granted the joint application of M-Power and Otter Tail Corporation for transfer of Certificate of Site Compatibility No. 9, Certificate of Corridor Compatibility No. 106 and Route Permit No. 116 to Otter Tail Corporation.

As noted in the Commission's October 30, 2008 Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and

Order in Case No. PU-08-34, M-Power would later proceed to either construct the Phase I portion of the Project, or seek approval to transfer the Certificate for Phase I to a regional or national developer.

A hearing to consider more evidence regarding the application of M-Power for the Certificate to construct the remaining 120 MW Phase I of the proposed Luverne wind farm in Griggs and Steele Counties, North Dakota (the "Project") is scheduled for June 5, 2009 in Case No. PU-08-34.

On June 2, 2009, in Case No. PU-09-221, M-Power, LLC and Ashtabula Wind II, LLC submitted a joint application for the transfer of the anticipated Certificate of Site Compatibility for Energy Conversion Facility for Phase I of the Project to Ashtabula Wind II, LLC.

M-Power and Ashtabula Wind II, LLC executed a Purchase and Sale Agreement, dated May 22, 2009, pursuant to which Ashtabula Wind II, LLC would purchase all of M-Power's interest in Phase I of the project. Ashtabula Wind II, LLC will construct and own Phase I of the project. The closing of the Purchase and Sale Agreement will not occur prior to the June 5, 2009 hearing on M-Power's application for the Cer-

tificate.

The issues to be considered in these matters are whether Ashtabula Wind II, LLC agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of the certificate issued to M-Power, and whether the requested transfer is compatible with the public interest.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding(s) and the reasons for requesting a hearing. Comments and requests for hearing must be received by July 6, 2009. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.

NDGF continues walleye tagging at Devils Lake

The final year of a three-year project is underway at Devils Lake as North Dakota Game and Fish Department fisheries personnel recently tagged 1,000 walleye.

A total of 3,000 walleye were tagged for the project, which allows biologists to gather information on walleye movements, total fish mortality between years, angling mortality rates and differences in mortality rates between sexes.

This year's tags are blue - while last year's were yellow and in 2007 orange - and are attached by wire to the top of the fish. The tag does not need to be sent in, just the information: tag number, kept

or released, date caught, length, location and angler's name and address.

Anglers catching a tagged fish are encouraged to report it online at the Game and Fish Department website, gf.nd.gov. Also, tag return cards can be filled out at bait shops around the lake, or anglers can bring in the information or call the Devils Lake Game and Fish office at 662-3617.

A follow-up letter will be sent to the angler with information such as when and where the fish was tagged, and fish length at the time it was tagged.
