ORDER ISSUING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE & NECESSITY

November 12, 2009

On June 2, 2009, Otter Tail Corporation, an electric public utility, filed an application under Chapter 49-03, N.D.C.C. to extend electrical service to City of Bottineau's Sewer Lift Station at a location in Bottineau County, North Dakota.

Effective July 1, 2009, as part of a corporate restructuring, Otter Tail Corporation changed its corporate name to Otter Tail Power Company.

On August 26, 2009, the Commission issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing in this proceeding. The Notice provided if no objections were received by October 1, 2009, the application would be granted as requested. No objections have been received.


