ORDER AUTHORIZING LIMITED OPERATIONS

December 31, 2009

Organic Grain and Milling, Inc., Boulder, Colorado, operates a licensed public grain warehouse at Clyde, North Dakota, under license no. 1156 issued by the Public Service Commission under the provisions of N.D.C.C. Chapter 60-02.

On October 19, 2009, the Commission received notice that the warehouseman bond issued to Organic Grain and Milling, Inc. would be cancelled on January 27, 2010. N.D.C.C. § 60-02-09.1 provides that the Commission shall immediately suspend an elevator's license if the licensee fails to file a replacement bond at least thirty days before cancellation of the current bond filing. As of December 28, 2009, no replacement bond had been filed with the Commission.

On December 29, 2009, the Commission received a request from Organic Grain and Milling, Inc. for authorization to conduct limited operations to satisfy obligations to ship cleaned and packed organic HRS wheat against a contract established on August 18, 2009.

On December 31, 2009, the Commission adopted an Order Suspending Warehouse License Number 1156 of Organic Grain and Milling, Inc., at their Clyde, North Dakota, warehouse, effective December 29, 2009, for lack of adequate bond and issued a Notice of Opportunity to be Heard.


Order

The Commission orders Organic Grain and Milling, Inc. be authorized to ship cleaned and packed organic HRS wheat, as provided in its December 29, 2009 request, until an adequate bond has been procured, filed, and approved by the Commission.
