NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING

On August 12, 2009, Montana-Dakota Utilities Co., a Division of MDU Resources Group, Inc., an electric public utility, filed an application under Chapter 49-03, N.D.C.C. to extend service to EOG Resources at a location in Ross, in Mountrail County, North Dakota.

Submitted with the application was a statement from the customer, EOG Resources, that they desire electric service to be provided by the applicant at a point located in:

**SE ¼, Section 18, Township 156N, Range 92W,
Mountrail County, North Dakota**

Montana-Dakota Utilities Co. states that electric service is needed at this location immediately, and the applicant has made a prima facie showing that it should serve the customer.

Any interested party has the right to file written objection, based on the issue of public convenience and necessity, with the Commission by **October 1, 2009**, and the matter will then be set for hearing. If no objections are received by that date, the application may be granted as requested.
