
Submitted with the application was a statement from the customer, Chad Weckerly, that he desires electric service to be provided by the applicant at a point located in:

SE ¼, Section 24, Township 146N, Range 73W,
Wells County, North Dakota

Otter Tail Corporation states that electric service is needed at this location immediately, and the applicant has made a prima facie showing that it should serve the customer.

Any interested party has the right to file written objection, based on the issue of public convenience and necessity, with the Commission by **October 1, 2009**, and the matter will then be set for hearing. If no objections are received by that date, the application may be granted as requested.
