ORDER ISSUING CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE & NECESSITY

November 12, 2009

Effective July 1, 2009, as part of a corporate restructuring, Otter Tail Corporation changed its corporate name to Otter Tail Power Company.

On August 10, 2009, Otter Tail Power Company, formerly known as Otter Tail Corporation, an electric public utility, filed an application under Chapter 49-03, N.D.C.C. to extend electrical service to Chad Weckerly at a location in Wells County, near Hurdsfield, North Dakota.

On August 26, 2009, the Commission issued a Notice of Opportunity for Hearing in this proceeding. The Notice provided if no objections were received by October 1, 2009, the application would be granted as requested. No objections have been received.


