

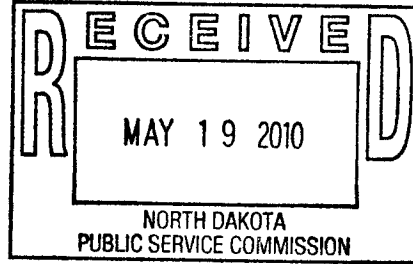

NOTICE OF HEAIRNG

YOU ARE HEREBY NOTIFIED that a Complaint has been filed by the Public Service Commission of the state of North Dakota alleging that you have violated certain provisions of North Dakota Century Code chapter 49-23 as follows:

See Complaint (Case No. WM-09-640) dated April 29, 2010, served upon you on May 13, 2010.

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the provisions of N.D.C.C.28-32 and 49-23, an administrative hearing on the matter will be held at 9:00 a.m. on July 19, 2010, in the PSC Hearing Room, Twelfth Floor, State Capitol, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck , North Dakota. You are hereby required to appear at the hearing, with an attorney if you desire, to answer the allegations of the Complaint.


Both parties will be given an opportunity to respond to all evidence presented at the hearing. Any party presenting documentation at the hearing should be prepared to provide the documentation in triplicate - one copy for the administrative law judge, one copy for the opposing party, and one copy for the presenting party. The hearing will be recorded for review.

A transcript of the recorded hearing can be made available, and the costs of the transcript will be assessed to the requesting party.

No later than 10 days prior to the hearing, each party must provide to the administrative law judge and to the other party a witness list and an exhibit list. The lists shall state each exhibit the party intends to offer at the hearing and each witness the party intends to call at the hearing. If a list includes an expert witness, the list must also state the subject matter on which the expert is expected to testify, the substance of the facts and opinions to which the expert is expected to testify, and a summary of the grounds for each opinion.


