IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT DRINKING WATER AT ROUND PRAIRIE SCHOOL
 The Selenium levels of drinking water at Round Prairie School are above drinking water standards established by the North Dakota Department of Health. The water well system at Round Prairie School recently violated a drinking water standard. This was discovered during a regular check of the water well by the North Dakota Department of Health. Although this is not an emergency, Round Prairie patrons and students have a right to know what New Public School District #8 is doing to rectify the problem. The District would ask that the public please help disseminate this information to anyone who may utilize the Round Prairie School facility.
 New Public School District #8 routinely monitors for the presence of drinking water contaminants. The most recent Selenium analysis indicated that the running annual average (RAA) of Selenium in the well at Round Prairie is (0.03 mg/l), which is greater than the Maximum Contaminant Level (MCL) for Selenium. The MCL for Selenium is (0.06 mg/l). Additionally, Round Prairie School has completed four quarters of monitoring for Selenium and the running annual average (RAA) for these samples is (0.06 mg/l).
 The North Dakota Department of Health is not requiring Round Prairie to utilize another source for drinking water, but the school has provided bottled water for students and staff for a number of years. The school will continue to do this as long as the school is viable.
 This is not an immediate risk. If it had been, the public would have been notified immediately. It must be noted that Selenium is an essential nutrient. Unfortunately, some people who drink water containing Selenium in excess of the MCL over many years could experience hair or fingernail losses, numbness in fingers or toes, or problems with their circulation.
 To remedy this, New Public School District #8 will continue to require students and staff to drink the bottled water that is provided, and meals will continue to be prepared with bottled water. Signs will be posted at the Round Prairie School site warning parents, students, patrons, and visitors of the Selenium contamination.
