On February 18, 2011, Minnkota Power Cooperative, Inc. (Minnkota) filed an application for a Certificate of Site Compatibility for Transmission Facility Corridor for approximately 260 miles of 345 kV transmission line and associated facilities to be constructed from the Center Substation near Center, North Dakota to the Prairie Substation near Grand Forks, North Dakota, as shown on the attached map. Minnkota requests the Commission approve a 1,000 foot-wide corridor under N.D. Admin. Code Section 69-06-04-02(b). If a corridor certificate is granted then a separate route permit application and hearing is required before designating a transmission line

route within the approved corridor. Three separate public hearings will be held with each covering an overview of the project, but focusing on specific portions of the project in the specific areas of each hearing. A Public Hearing on the application will be held:

May 3, 2011, 9:00 a.m. at the Grand Forks County Building Conference Room, 151 S 4th Street, Grand Forks, ND 58201. This hearing will focus primarily on portions of the project in Grand Forks, Nelson and Steele Counties

May 4, 2011, 9:00 a.m. at the Chief-tain Conference Center Tepee Room, 60 4th Ave. S, Carrington, ND 58204. This hearing will focus primarily on portions of the project in Eddy, Foster, Griggs, eastern Sheridan and Wells Counties

May 13, 2011, 9:00 a.m. at Memorial Hall, 805 Main Ave. Washburn, ND 58577. This hearing will focus primarily on portions of the project in Burleigh, McLean, Oliver and western Sheridan Counties.

The issues to be considered are:  
1. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities

produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?  
2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?  
3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?  
4. Is it appropriate for the Commission to approve a 1,000 foot-wide corridor as requested in the application? 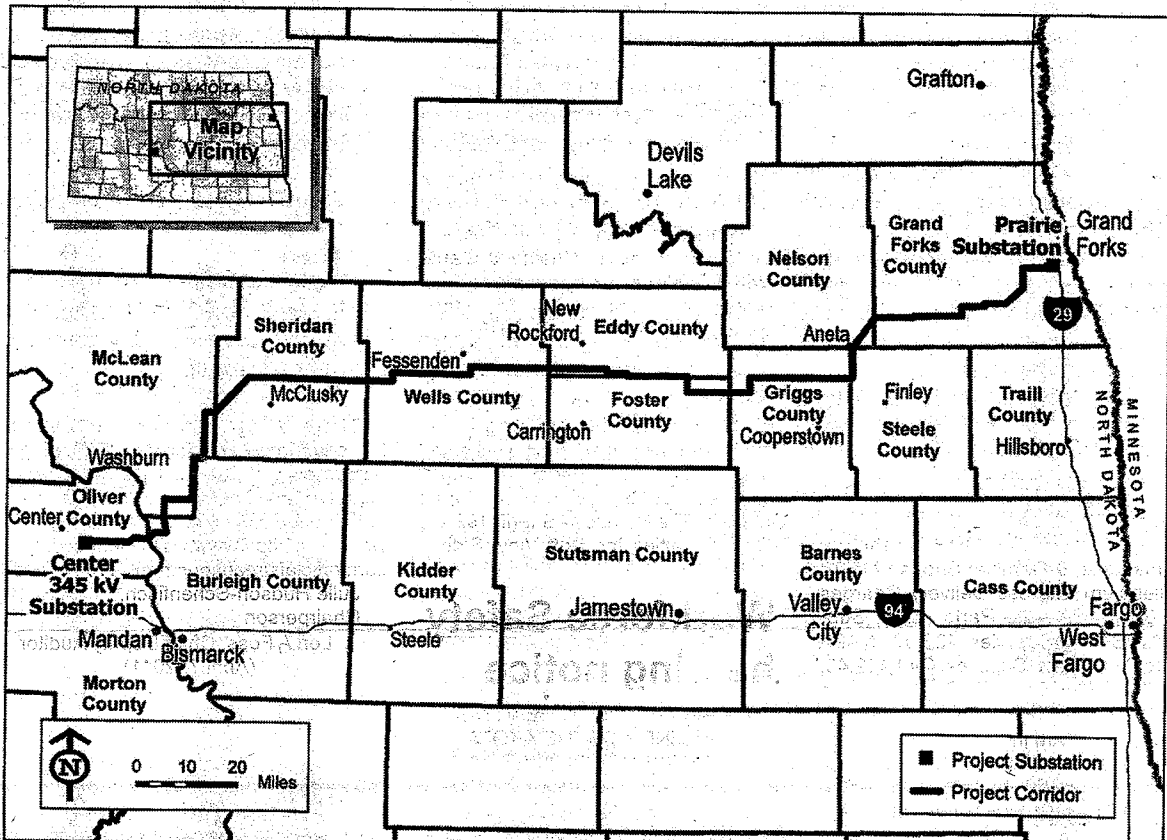

PUBLIC NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY TO COMMENT ON A DRAFT PERMIT MODIFICATION FOR SURFACE IMPOUNDMENTS UNDER THE NORTH DAKOTA SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT RULES  
FACILITY NAME: Great River Energy - Coal Creek Station, Permit Number 0033

APPLICANT: Great River Energy, Maple Grove, MN  
BACKGROUND: On February 11, 2011, the Department received from Golder Associates, Inc. (Golder), on behalf of Great River Energy (GRE), an application proposing modification of its surface impoundments, regulated under Solid Waste Permit 0033. The plant lies in the SW1/4 of Section 17, Township 145N, Range 82W of McLean County, or six miles south of Underwood, ND. The initial permit for the operation of a special waste facility at Coal Creek Station was issued on July 13, 1983. Solid Waste Permit 0033 was most recently modified and renewed on September 28, 2010. The proposed modification would vertically extend the composite liner and embankment at the Evaporation Ponds. The operation of other solid waste management units included in this permit will remain unchanged. The Department believes that this permit modification will meet the requirements of the North Dakota Solid Waste Management Rules and is protective of human health and the environment.

PUBLIC COMMENTS AND HEARING: As required by Section 33-20-03.1-03 of the North Dakota Administrative Code, information regarding the proposed modifications will be available for public review and comment for thirty (30) days beginning on April 7, 2011 and ending on May 9, 2011. During that period any interested person may submit written comments and request a public hearing by stating the nature of the specific issues to be raised. A fifteen (15) day notice will be provided before any hearing is scheduled. The North Dakota Department of Health will consider all comments prior to taking any action on the permit modification.
