NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING AND AVAILABILITY OF ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT CONCERNING IMPROVEMENTS AT MOHALL MUNICIPAL AIRPORT MOHALL, ND

The City of Mohall, in cooperation with the Federal Aviation Administration and the North Dakota Aeronautics Commission, announces that a Public Hearing will be held on Tuesday, January 26, 2010 from 7:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. at the Mohall City Hall, 203 E Main St., Mohall, ND. This Hearing is being held to present and discuss the proposed action and the economic, social, and environmental effects of the proposed action. Exhibits will be on display. Representatives from Kadrimas, Lee & Jackson will be available to answer your questions and receive your comments.

Notice is hereby given of the availability of the Environmental Assessment for the proposed action at the Mohall Municipal Airport. An Environmental Assessment was prepared pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 to assess the environmental impacts associated with the proposed action. The preferred alternative consists of the following:

Extend Runway 13-31 approximately 480 feet to the northwest for a total length of 3,600 feet. Install turnaround (approximately 80 feet by 175 feet). Relocate PAPI's (Precision Approach Path Indicators) on Runway 13 end. Install signs and markings. Extend existing MIRL (medium intensity runway lighting) along the proposed runway extension. Install edge drain system. Acquire approximately 64 to 96 acres of land. Provide environmental clearance

for the potential release of land no longer needed for Airport purposes (approximately 74 acres). Remove obstructions (approximately 4 trees). Mitigate wildlife hazards: install wildlife fence and mitigate approximately 22.7 acres of non-jurisdictional wetlands (wildlife hazard attractants). Acquisition of property (and release of property) shall follow the Uniform Relocation Assistance and Real Property Acquisition Policies Act of 1970 (Uniform Act).

NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR COMMENT

December 10, 2009

On November 19, 2009, United Telephone Mutual Aid Corporation (United) entered into an interconnection agreement with Midcontinent Communications (Midcontinent) pursuant to Section 251 of the Telecommunications Act of 1996 (Act). The agreement set forth terms and conditions under which United provides interconnection services, local number portability, ancillary services and wholesale services for resale to Midcontinent. The agreement was filed with the Commission on December 2, 2009. On December 9, 2009, United filed a request for approval of the interconnection agreement in less

than 90 days pursuant to 47 U.S.C. B 252(e)(1).

This agreement was filed under Section 252(e) of the Telecommunications Act of 1996. The Act requires that any agreement adopted by negotiation or arbitration be submitted for approval to the Commission. Under 47 U.S.C. B 252(e)(2)(A), the Commission may only reject an agreement adopted by negotiation (or a portion of the agreement) if it finds that:

1. the agreement discriminates against a telecommunications carrier that was not a party to the agreement; or

2. implementation of the agreement is not consistent with the public interest, convenience, and necessity. In addition, under 47 U.S.C. Section 253 the Commission may include, in its review, state requirements that do not constitute barriers to entry. The Commission will receive written comments on this agreement until January 25, 2010.
