 NOTICE OF FILING AND NOTICE OF HEARING
 May 12, 2010**

On March 19, 2010, NextEra Energy Resources, LLC (NextEra) filed an application for a waiver of procedures and time schedules, a corridor certificate and a route permit to authorize construction of 11 miles of 230 kV electric transmission line and associated facilities in Morton and Oliver Counties of North Dakota, as shown on the attached map. On May 12, 2010 NextEra requested to transfer this case to its subsidiary, Oliver Wind III, LLC as the applicant. Oliver Wind III, LLC requests the Commission waive procedures and time schedules set forth in North Dakota Century Code chapter 49-22 and North Dakota Administrative Code article 69-06 to allow for a single consolidated application for corridor certificate and route permit and to hold a combined hearing on the waiver request and application for corridor certificate and route permit.

A Public Hearing on the application is scheduled to begin June 24, 2010, at 9:00 a.m. CDT, at the Civic Center, 204 Lincoln Ave. N, Center, North Dakota 58530. The issues to be considered

- are:
1. Will the location, construction, and operation of the proposed facilities produce minimal adverse effects on the environment and upon the welfare of the citizens of North Dakota?
 2. Are the proposed facilities compatible with the environmental preservation and the efficient use of resources?
 3. Will the proposed facility locations minimize adverse human and environmental impact while ensuring continuing system reliability and integrity and ensuring that energy needs are met and fulfilled in an orderly and timely fashion?
 4. Is it appropriate for the Commission to waive procedures and time schedules as requested, including the request for a single consolidated application for corridor certificate and route permit?

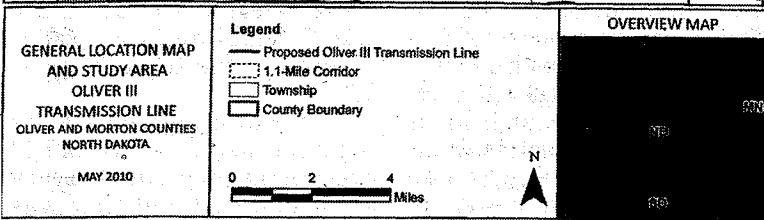
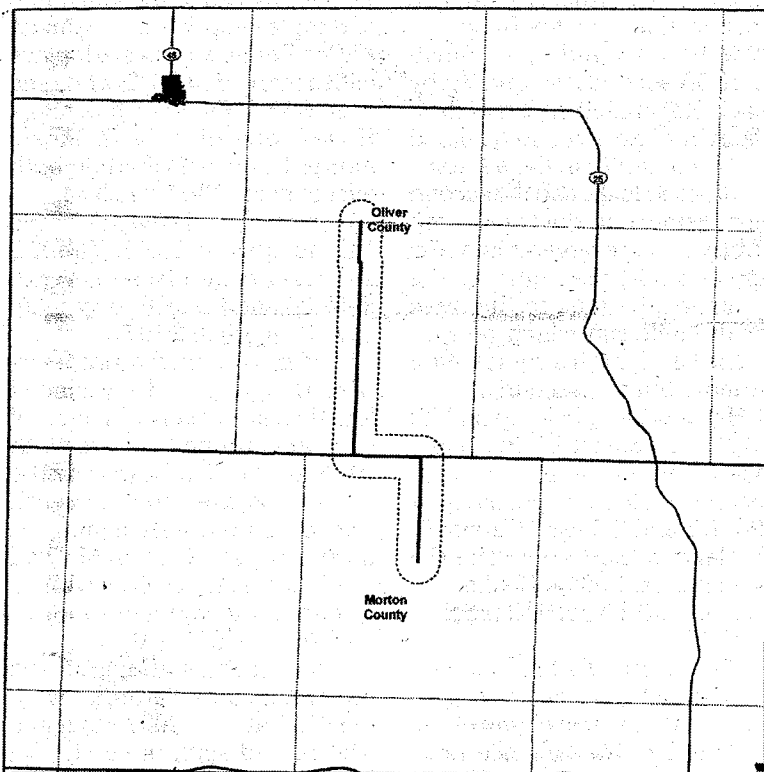
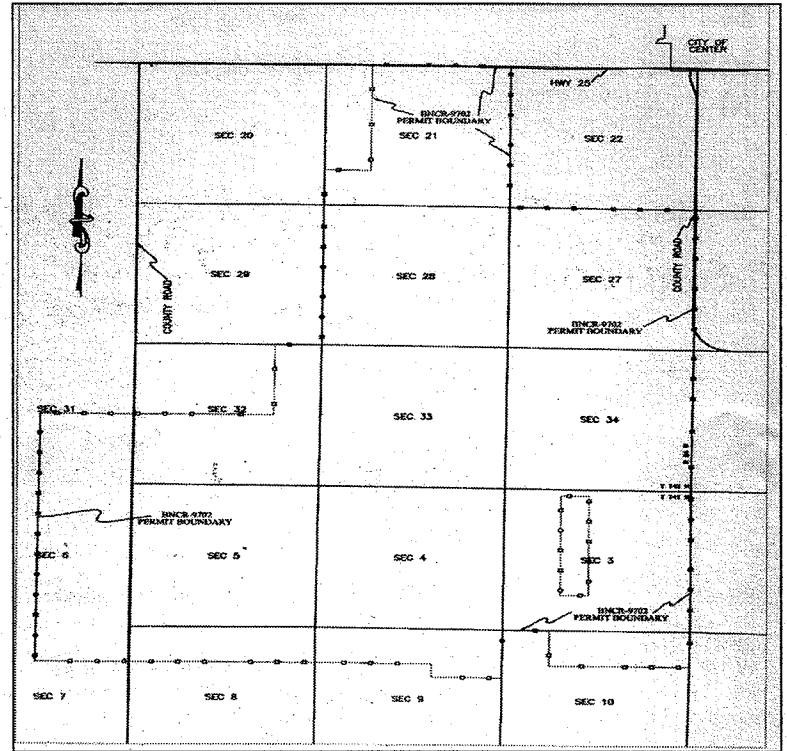
NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR A RENEWAL AND A REVISION OF A PERMIT TO ENGAGE IN SURFACE COAL MINING AND RECLAMATION ACTIVITIES.


Please take notice that BNI Coal Ltd., 2360 35th Avenue SW, Center, North Dakota 58530-9499 has submitted an application to the North Dakota Public Service Commission for Permit Renewal No. 2 and Permit Revision No. 32 to BNCR-9702, approved on August 2, 2000, to engage in surface coal mining and reclamation operations. The area for which a permit renewal and revision is sought includes approximately 6,342 acres in parts of Sections 21, 27, 28, 31, 32, 33 and 34 T142N R84W and parts of Sections 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9 and 10 T141N R84W. This area is in Oliver County, North Dakota and is shown on the accompanying map. Renewal No. 2 will extend the permit term another five years for coal removal until August 2, 2015. The permit revision will update the legal and financial section, reclamation, operational and wildlife monitoring plans.

Any person whose interests are or may be adversely affected by the proposed action has the right to file written comments, objections or request an informal conference with the North Dakota Public Service Commission. Written comments, objections, requests for informal conferences and petitions should be sent to the Public Service Commission, 600 East Boulevard, Bismarck, ND 58505-0480 within 30 days after the final date of publication of this notice. A copy of the permit application is available for inspection at the Office of the Auditor, Oliver County Courthouse, Center, ND 58530 and the Office of the Director of the Reclamation Division, Public Service Commission, 600 East Boulevard Avenue, Bismarck, ND 58505-0480.
