My name is Liz France and I am the Project Director for the archaeological survey portion of the Bridger Pipeline project. On October 19-20, 2010 and November 2, 2010, a crew was sent from our office to conduct surveys of four late reroutes along portions of the proposed Bridger Pipeline. During the course of the survey, two additional cultural resources were recorded. An Isolated find was located in Section 1, of T. 150N, R. 96W, McKenzie County. Isolated finds are not considered eligible for inclusion to the National Register of Historic Places, therefore no avoidance was recommended. A small site was located in Section 24, of T. 147N, R. 96W, Dunn County. Bridger agreed to avoid this site during construction. Once our office has submitted the site form and received a SITS number from the North Dakota State Historic Preservation Office, We will submit a copy of our addendum report to your office.
