License Suspension/Revocation

The grain warehouse bond for Organic Grain and Milling, Inc. is scheduled to expire on January 27, 2010. N.D.C.C. § 60-02-09.1 requires that unless the warehouseman files a new bond at least thirty days before liability ceases, the Commission, without hearing, shall immediately suspend the warehouseman's license and the suspension may not be removed until a new bond has been filed and approved by the Commission. As of December 28, 2009, no replacement bond was filed with the Commission.

Attached are a motion and order suspending the grain warehouse license of Organic Grain and Milling, Inc. at Clyde, North Dakota, effective December 29, 2009. The order sets forth compliances for the licensee. Organic Grain and Milling, Inc. has until January 27, 2010, to procure and file an adequate bond or submit a written request for hearing.
