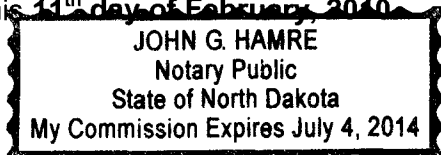

ORDER REVOKING WAREHOUSE LICENSE
AND ORDERING RETURN OF LICENSE

February 10, 2010

Organic Grain and Milling, Inc. Boulder, Colorado operates a licensed public grain warehouse at Clyde, North Dakota, under license no. 1156 issued by the Public Service Commission under the provisions of N.D.C.C. Chapter 60-02.

On October 19, 2009, the Commission received notice that the warehouseman bond issued to Organic Grain and Milling, Inc. would be cancelled on January 27, 2010. The public grain warehouse license issued to Organic Grain and Milling, Inc. was suspended effective December 29, 2009 pursuant to N.D.C.C. § 60-02-09.1. The company had until January 27, 2010, to procure and file an adequate bond. No bond filing was received.


N.D.C.C. § 60-02-10.1 provides that the Commission may revoke the license of any warehouseman for cause upon notice and hearing. Organic Grain and Milling, Inc. was notified that they had until January 27, 2010, to submit a written request for hearing and no request for hearing was received.

Order


The Commission orders:

1. Public grain warehouse license no. 1156 issued to Organic Grain and Milling, Inc. at Clyde, North Dakota is revoked for failure to maintain adequate bond coverage as provided in N.D.C.C. § 60-02-10.1.
2. Organic Grain and Milling, Inc. shall return public grain warehouse license number 1156 to the Commission.


