
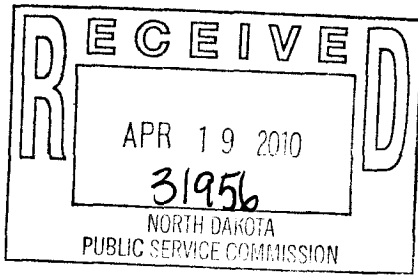



**NOTICE OF RECEIPT OF REVISION APPLICATION**

The Falkirk Mining Company has filed the application for Revision No. 19 to Surface Coal Mining Permit NAFK-9503 to mine additional lands in Sections 15, 21, 22, 28, and 33, T145N, R83W resulting in changes to the post-mining topography and reclamation schedules within the permit area. This revision also updates business entity and environmental information and other operations and reclamation plans in the permit.

You may submit written comments or objections on the proposed permit revision application and its effects on the environment and on surface owners of the land in the permit area. You may request an informal conference with the Commission and the applicant on the revision application. The reasons for requesting an informal conference must be stated in the request. Written comments, objections, or requests for informal conference must be made by April 19, 2010.

If there is an informal conference, you may request a formal administrative hearing on the Commission ruling on the application. Your request for a formal hearing must be made within thirty days of the Commission ruling on the application.
