Preliminary Statement
On January 11, 2010, BNI Coal, Ltd. applied for a permit revision to add 676.48 acres to Surface Coal Mining Permit No. BNCR-9702 for its mine near Center, North Dakota. The added acreage is located in portions of Sections 21, 29, and 32, T142N, R84W, Oliver County. The revision provides the required baseline data and updates mining and reclamation plans for the additional area.

The Commission has completed its review of the application and conditionally approved the permit revision. The revision gives BNI Coal, Ltd. the right to conduct mining operations on the additional area and otherwise modify mining and reclamation plans in Permit No. BNCR-9702 as described in the revision application.
