Subject: Enbridge Pipelines (North Dakota) LLC, Case No. PU-10-33
Pre-construction Conference

In Case No. PU-10-33, Enbridge notified the Commission of the construction of a tank for storage of crude petroleum at its Stanley Station, located in Mountrail County. Enbridge certified under North Dakota Century Code section 49-22-03(3) that (1) the location for the intended construction is on a site for which Enbridge has previously obtained a Certificate of Site Compatibility for Transmission Facility and a Route Permit, (2) the construction activities to take place will not affect any known exclusion or avoidance area, and (3) Enbridge will comply with all applicable conditions and protections in siting law and rules and Commission orders previously issued for any part of the Stanley Station. The Commission had previously issued orders for the Stanley Station in Case Nos. PU-08-812 and PU-07-791.

On January 28, 2010 a pre-construction conference was held (by conference call). In attendance were Fred Washek (Construction Coordinator, Enbridge), Todd Fehn (On-site Inspector, Enbridge), Jim Watts (Enbridge, Legal Counsel), Ty France (Project Manager, Rooney Engineering), Eric Stahl (Lead Engineer, Rooney Engineering), Troy Pierantoni (Project Execution Manager, Rooney Engineering), and myself.

The conference included a review of the ordering clauses from Case Nos. PU-08-812 and PU-07-791, the penalty provisions of NDCC § 49-22-21, and a question and answer period.
