**NOTICE OF OPPORTUNITY FOR HEARING
March 24, 2010**

On April 29, 2009, in Case No. PU-07-54, the Commission issued Certificate of Site Compatibility for Energy Conversion Facility No. 11 to Just Wind, LLC. authorizing construction of its Logan County Wind Farm consisting of up to 368 MW of wind turbine generating capacity, collection substation and associated facilities in Logan County, North Dakota.

On March 5, 2010, in Case No. PU-10-58, Just Wind, LLC and Logan County Wind Farm, LLC submitted a joint application for the transfer of Certificate of Site Compatibility for Energy Conversion Facility No. 11 to Logan County Wind Farm, LLC, a wholly-owned subsidiary of Just Wind, LLC.

The issues to be considered in these matters are whether Logan County Wind Farm, LLC agrees and is able to comply with the terms and conditions of the certificate issued to Just Wind, LLC, and whether the requested transfer is compatible with the public interest.

Those interested are invited to comment on the application in writing. Persons desiring a hearing must file a written request identifying their interest in the proceeding and the reasons for requesting a hearing. Comments and requests for hearing must be received by **April 30, 2010**. If deemed appropriate, the Commission can determine the matter without a hearing.
