Subject: FPL Energy Oliver Wind II, LLC, 48.0 MW Wind Energy Center - Center, ND, Decommissioning Plan & Cost (Case No. PU-10-110)

On July 23, 2020, the Commission approved a \$4 million decommissioning parent guarantee for FPL Energy Oliver Wind II, LLC.

On November 18, 2020, the Commission received notice that FPL Energy Oliver Wind II, LLC's assets were transferred to Oliver Wind Energy Center II, LLC (Oliver II). Oliver II has a nameplate capacity of 48 MWs and consists of 32 1.5 MW turbines.

On November 18, 2020 in the same filing, Oliver II filed a decommissioning parent guarantee for \$4 million to replace the decommissioning parent guarantee approved by the Commission on July 23, 2020. The guarantor, NextEra Energy Capital Holdings, Inc., is the guarantor on both guarantees. However, the parent guarantee now reflects Oliver Wind Energy Center II, LLC as the owner per the name change in Case No. PU-20-456.

Staff has reviewed Oliver II's parent guarantee and recommends approval since the guarantee now reflects Oliver Wind Energy Center II, LLC as the owner per the name change, and the guarantor of the agreement did not change.
